

Due to the current Coronavirus pandemic and circumstances beyond our control, Sebasticook Lake Campground (SLC) has adopted the following rules and regulations which go into effect immediately and until further notice. These rules have been put into place in response to the Executive Order handed down to Maine campgrounds on April 29, 2020 in EO 34 FY 19/20 & EO 49 <https://www.maine.gov/governor/mills/sites/maine.gov/governor.mills/files/inline-files/An%20Order%20to%20Stay%20Safer%20at%20Home.pdf> . Counties and municipalities may also impose additional restrictions which may come down the road

This addendum can be printed out and scanned backed to the campground at info@mainervpark.com or given upon arrival to the campground. Either method will be accepted.

Sebasticook Lake Campground 2020 Guest Agreement due to COVID 19

- * No one shall enter campground property who exhibits flu like symptoms which include but are not limited to cough, fever, or shortness of breath.
- * No one shall enter campground property who has knowingly come in contact with someone who has tested positive for Coronavirus who has not first quarantined for 14 days.
- * SLC is not liable for any person who may contract any airborne illness as a result of being on campground property.
- * Campers and their guest are entering camp at their own risk and should follow guidelines set forth by the CDC in regard to underlying risk factors and personal safety.
- * Campers will limit local grocery trips to “essential” needs only and attempt to bring all supplies from home to limit contact with others and minimize the potential of spread of disease in our local stores.
- * It is the camper’s responsibility to be wise to and abide by any change in campground procedures, guidelines, or restrictions imposed by SLC which may result from any superseding executive orders by government officials.
- * SLC will communicate any changes (please allow emails from info@mainervpark.com to avoid missing them in your spam/junk folder), in person, and/or via our Facebook page/Group. When in doubt, ask us!
- * All public areas and any “gathering places” are closed. This includes, but is not limited to, the office, camp store, bathrooms, shower house, pool, playground, basketball court.
- * There will be no campground sponsored activities or events.
- * NO GUESTS Prior to June 1st. And all guest after June 1st must be Maine residents and show proper ID.
- * Visitation on another campsite is permitted and must be enforced by the 6ft rule and no more than 10 people.
- * Practice Social Distancing guidelines. • Biking, hiking, fishing, canoeing & kayaking (personal equipment only) is allowed.
 - Personal golf cart use is permitted but only people that live in your household or your personal guest after June 1st are allowed on your personal golf cart, (Golf cart can not have more occupants than there is seating for)
 - There will no golf cart sharing or borrowing of golf carts by other guest or anyone renting another campsite.

*Campers should not allow other campers adults/children into your camper as to protect your personal space.

* It is your responsibility to make sure that your children are maintaining the 6ft rule and any guest that you have visit you. (Children under 10 should have more adult supervision during COVID, if children are observed not maintaining their distancing you will be required to stay with your child when they are not at your campsite as they are young and forget)

I/We understand that if there is a violation of any rule(s), SLC has the right to fully or temporarily evict any person or all persons listed on your site without restitution until orders are lifted.

_____ I/We DO NOT agree to this addendum. We understand that we cannot enter onto SLC property until the order is lifted or until we agree to sign and abide to the addendum. We understand that we will not receive restitution as a result of our decision and will still be required to make seasonal payment as agreed to in our signed seasonal agreement.
